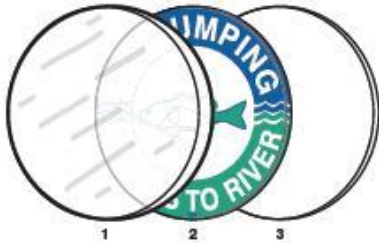

E Economark Style Markers *Abrasion Resistant*

The das Economark Curb Marker is made from a .030 clear polycarbonate (lexan) with the image imprinted on the reverse side. It is then double flood coated with white.

 - 3 Double Flood-Coat White

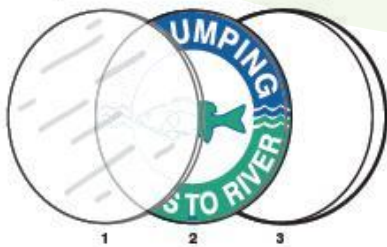

S Standard Style Markers *UV Resistant*

The das Standard Curb Marker is made from a .030 opaque white plastic. This proprietary material contains U.V. inhibitors and a layering of materials for flexibility and impact resistance. The printing is on the surface of the material which is then covered with our SolarShield™ clear coat for added U.V. resistance.

 - 3 .030 Opaque White Plastic Base

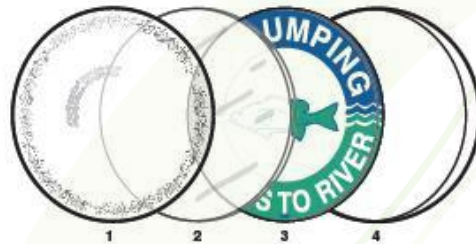

D Duracast™ Style Markers *Abrasion & UV Resistant*

This das Duracast Curb Marker is the same as the Standard with one additional feature. A polyurethane “dome” is applied to the face of the marker. This optically clear, self-healing, non-yellowing, Duracast surface protects against mechanical and chemical abrasion. The Duracast surface effectively doubles U.V. resistance as well.

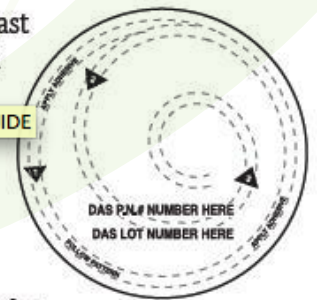

NS No-Slip™ Surface

das offers a No-Slip finish on many Stock and Custom Duracast Style markers. An optically clear granular material is imbedded in the surface providing an abrasive finish. The surface exceeds ADA minimum recommendations for surfaces in public areas.
